Hopewell's School Council welcomes everyone to an exciting new school year! We look forward to spending time with all members of our school community: parents, guardians, extended family, teachers, school staff, community organizations, and our students.

As a parent/guardian of a Hopewell student, you are already part of the school council! School Council is a perfect way to stay involved and have input into your child's education experience. We welcome all to become involved through ideas, time, expertise, and any other contributions one might make to benefit Hopewell's school community.

Over the past years, Hopewell School Council, along with the staff and students, discussed, organized and executed many activities and programs in the school. Even though the pandemic put many school council activities on hold, last year we saw a renewed enthusiasm for School Council events, including Bike and Ski sales, yard improvements, transportation and safety around the school, Panago pizza and Subway lunches, monthly coffee chats on wellness, a parent evening out with OSCA, discussions with OCDSB school board trustees, and supporting the grade 8 leaving party.

Hopewell School Council plans to continue existing initiatives and establish new ones that benefit the school community, specifically our children. The school council meets monthly to discuss, plan, and implement programs. We generally meet during the school year on the third Tuesday of each month. School Council Committees

Committees (as written in the Constitution, articles 38-43):

The council may establish committees as necessary. A motion at a council meeting establishes committees. The motion shall set out the committee's mandate. Membership on such committees shall not be restricted to council members, although each committee shall include at least one parent/guardian member of the council. Each committee shall have a chair or spokesperson, to be elected by the committee or appointed by the council, who shall act as the first contact for people outside the committee.

- Committees may be terminated by council vote and shall be deemed to expire at the end of each council term.
- Committees do not represent the council but may seek council approval of draft communications or other actions or representations.
- Committees may receive money from the council through procedures set by the council.
- Committees shall report to the council at least twice per council term.
- Committee meetings shall be open to the school community.



Our School Council Committees!

COMMITTEES

- **School Events** community spirit and Fun: this committee plans events (at minimum one or two) for this school year that brings connection, joy and togetherness to the Hopewell School community (Ski/Bike sale, digital game night, or possibly outdoor events, etc.). Members have a representative role during the first week of school, 'teacher-parent' evenings, and host a 'welcome table' with School Council information. One or a few creative people would be welcome to lead initiatives and events, and we are looking to put together a list of volunteers to call upon in supporting events.
- **Grade 8 Leaving celebration:** a group of grade 7 parent volunteers has traditionally prepared the festivities for the grade 8 celebrations, including decorations of the gym and hallways, coffee/tea or lunch buffet, and additional entertainment. A group of at least four grade 7 parents (ideally more) would be asked to step forward as volunteers in coordinating and planning the grade 8 cohort 2024.
- Yard Committee: oversees the maintenance and care of the schoolyard trees and mulch and organizes Spring and Fall clean-up (leaves, weeding, etc). The renovations of the Kinder yard and the primary yard have been scheduled and fundraised by the School Council in the past years with the support of many dedicated parent volunteers.
- **School Lunch and Pizza Day coordination:** has had a successful year in 2022/23. We are preparing to offer Pizza Fridays, a possible 2nd lunch day (under exploration), and Mazzola as a service to parents. The Pizza Day and added lunch day requires one/two coordinators and, at a minimum, six volunteers per Pizza Day (Person with day-time availability during lunch hours).
- **Budget Committee:** is in charge of proposing a budget for the respective School Council year. The Treasurer leads the committee and provides financial support for the School Council year vision, including fundraising needs and suggestions.
- **Communications:** to ensure the engagement of the wider community in the School Council, we must communicate key messages and takeaways from Council meetings. Reporting to the community about how School Council money is being spent (that has been raised, for example, through pizza) is important for accountability and maintaining continuous support. Currently, School Council mostly communicates via the Administration's weekly message and through the website and Facebook page.

REPRESENTATIVES

- **Grade representatives** are the ears to the ground of what happens in the respective classes/ grades. They bring up any issues that require attention beyond the class-specific level and are relevant to be raised in School Council (this role does take more than an hour per month in addition to school council attendance). They will regularly reach out to at least five parents in their grade (range of different classes) to poll ideas, hear stories and 'keep the ear to the ground.' Grade representatives develop an engagement plan together at the start of the year.
- **Teacher representative:** One of Hopewell's teachers represents staff during School Council meetings and reports monthly on updates and relevant information.
- OCASC representative: The person who attends OCASC meetings and represents Hopewell Ave School Council, called the External Representative (OCASC Rep), shall: i) Attend OCASC and/or other meetings on behalf of the council and speak for the council at such meetings (when necessary or applicable); ii) provide to council an oral and/or written report of OCASC and/or other meetings; iii) act as the council's link to OCASC and to other organizations with purposes similar to the council's.
- Wellness representative: takes part in the school Safe Caring and Wellness program on behalf of the School Council and brings back relevant information. In coordination with the Safe Caring and Wellness program, the representative proposes information, material, speaking opportunities, events etc., for the School Council to disseminate to the Hopewell community. Last year, we held monthly Parent Wellness Coffee Chats and an evening out for Parents!
