On Wednesday of this past week, access to Progress Reports (grades 1-8) and Initial Observations of Learning (Kindergarten) were sent out via our SchoolMessenger system. If you did not receive your child's Progress Report or Initial Observations of Learning message, please reach out to our school office. Progress Reports are designed to share information about a child's general progress in working towards their achievement of the curriculum expectations. Progress Reports do not include marks or letter grades, but rather progress will be reported by indicating if the student is "progressing very well", "progressing well", or "progressing with difficulty". This report is intended to provide parents with an early indication of their child's progress and will communicate areas of growth. Parent/guardian/teacher interviews will take place next Thursday evening and Friday morning. Details about interviews are in our School News section of this message.

This week OSTA and Hopewell held Emergency Bus Evacuation drills. All of our homeroom classes from Kinder to grade eight learned how to safely exit a yellow school bus in case of emergency. This is the first time in six years that we have been able to do so and our students did a fabulous job of listening, learning and evacuating safely. We are so proud of our Hopewell students.
